## Monday

## Tuesday

Biblical worldview means to view the world, people, problems, governments, issues, solutions, and the future through God’s Word. Problems and solutions are both spiritual and will not be solved through government intervention, education, or technology. The underlying problem is spiritual emptiness. (Proverbs 4:23, John 8:32)

## Wednesday

A Biblical worldview gives you confidence, answers for life’s problems and provides hope for the future. How you see yourself and world around you determines your quality of life, direction and destiny. Your beliefs determine your decisions, behaviors and outcomes. (John 15:5, Colossians 1:16)

- How do you see yourself and the world around you?

## Thursday

Your life is shaped by your thoughts/beliefs. If you don’t know what you believe or why you believe it, then your life is being shaped by something you’re not even aware of. What you believe governs your life. Often discontentment/disappointment with life is actually with outcomes created by decisions, based upon beliefs and thoughts. Bad outcomes point to errors in beliefs, which were not based on truth. (Romans 12:2, Ephesians 2:2)

## Friday

Answers and life are found in God and revealed by His Word. Everyone would benefit from having a Biblical Worldview. Though it requires them to believe and honor God’s Word (Bible). We need to start making decisions based on God’s instructions/values. (1 Peter 3:15, Proverbs 29:18)
