Monday

To live in a new reality, the issue of Lordship must be settled. Lordship is simply a matter of obedience. His commands show us what gives us life and what takes life. (Psalm 19:7-11, Deuteronomy 10:12-13)

- How do you define Lordship?

Tuesday

We must obey God immediately. Delayed obedience is still disobedience. Understanding is not a prerequisite for obedience. Don't wait till attitude and emotions are ready, just do it. (Palm 119:32, Psalm 119:60)

- What hurdles keep you from obeying God?

Wednesday

Obey God completely. Truth endures while culture continually changes. God's perspective/vantage point is bigger and better than ours. The oldest temptation isn't lust, lying, gluttony, or greed. The oldest temptation is to doubt and question God's Word. Obey God completely, He is into the details. (Isaiah 55:8-9, 2 Kings 5:9-14, Psalm 119:4)

- How has doubt challenged your obedience?

Thursday

Obey God joyfully. One measure of your love for God is your obedience to Him. (John 14:21-24, Psalm 100:2, Psalm 119:47)

- Joy is strength, how can this help you to obey?

Friday

Obey God continually. Consistency is what counts. What you do day by day takes you to your future. Living in a new reality, the issue of Lordship must be settled. It is a matter of obedience to the will of God. Let's spend the rest of your life doing God's will. (Psalm 119:33, Romans 6:16, 1 Peter 4:2-5)

- What is your next step in obeying God?
